2023 IGS Workshops

IGS asked the 2023 workshop teachers for their workshop classes to meet the following criteria:

- The workshops should be of a simple but interesting technique or gourd
- Students should end up with a completed technique or gourd at the end of the time allotted
- It should be completed in 3 hours or less and the cost should be \$35 or less

Over the years many workshop costs have risen, too high for many gourd artists to afford. Many times the technique or gourd is not completed in class and then many not completed at home. IGS hopes you will enjoy the basic techniques on gourds we are offering this year. IGS has fewer workshops offered, but we feel they all meet the criteria we set forth. Enjoy.

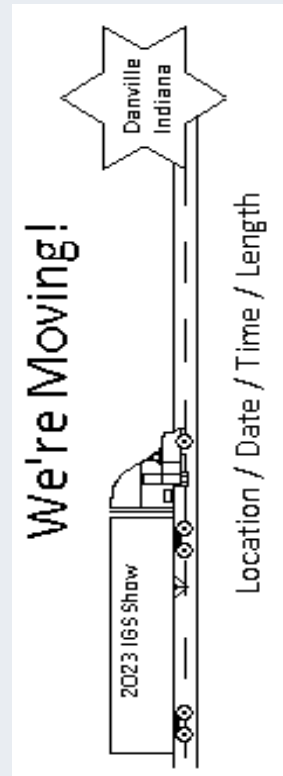
